

Pin Poke Pop Up Card:

1. Place stencil/card on some felt, a carpet square, any material that can withstand a push pin poking on it.
2. Following the lines of the drawing, punch out the shape, exactly on the line. The holes should be very close together. * This will make it very easy for the design to release from the paper.
3. It may take some time for your young child to poke or punch the holes...
4. Once all of the design has been pin poked - it will loosen. Your child may need an adult to help them release the design from the paper.

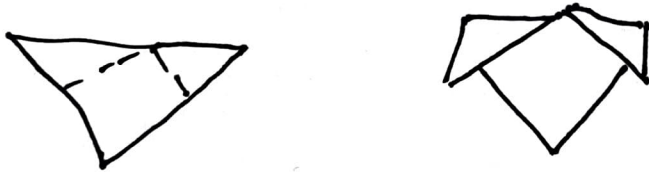
* Push pins are sharp and can be choking hazards. Please make sure that your child can use something sharp and that it is stored safely when not in use.*

To make a dog:

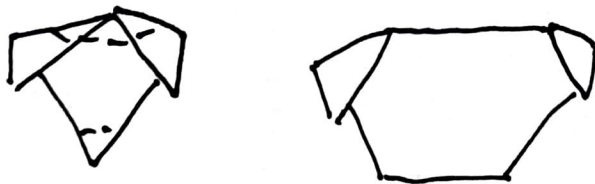
1. Start with a square sheet of paper. Fold the square to make a triangle.



2. Fold top corners of triangle down and forward. You should have a diamond shape with two triangle flaps.



3. Fold the top and bottom of the diamond down and backwards. Draw a dog face.

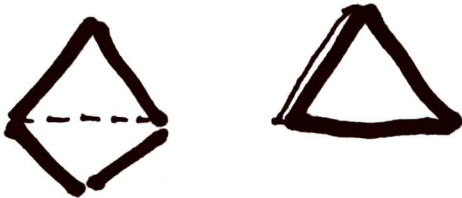

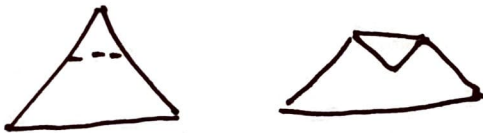


To make a cat:

1. Start with a square sheet of paper.
Fold the square to make a triangle.



2. Fold the top point of the triangle down and forward.



3. Fold the two bottom points up and forward, turn the paper around and draw a cat face.
